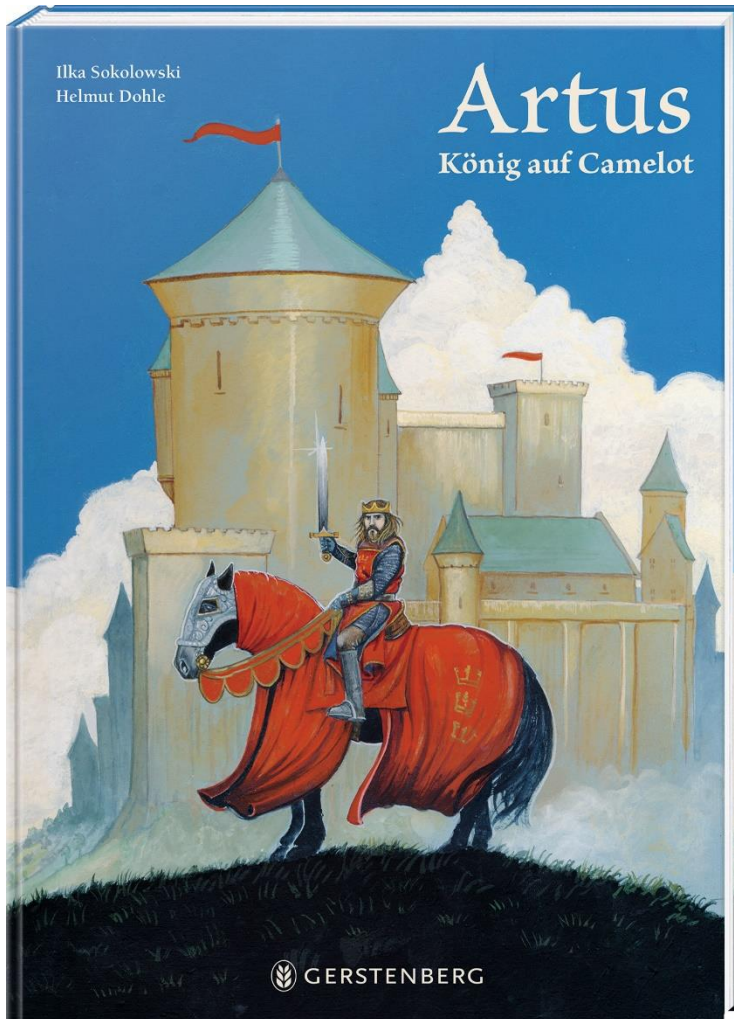


“Whoever releases the sword, will be the next king of Britannia!”
